PRINCIPAL REPORT...

Class Observations:

To provide an update to our school community, the beginning of this term has seen classroom teachers observed by myself and our Learning Specialist, Ben Rilen. The purpose of these observations has been to identify our current level of practice in our implementation of our evidence-based instructional model, referred to as Explicit Direct Instruction. Each observation typically lasts for 30-45 minutes, after which teachers receive coaching feedback on their practice observed. It has been fantastic to witness our teaching staff so willingly participate in this school improvement initiative and welcome the feedback provided, and indirectly, model to our children the importance of learning being an ongoing and important part of life.

Whilst the focus of these observations has primarily been on our teachers themselves, the beneficiaries are our children, as we can be confident the quality of instruction they receive is one that is backed by a large amount of research and evidence, and thus proven to have a positive impact on student learning. This improvement initiative will continue throughout the year, and I welcome parents and guardians to discuss this with our teaching staff if you would like to know more.






