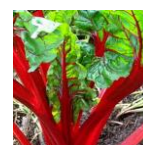
Mr John's Visit by Ceili Coulthard - Grade 2/3

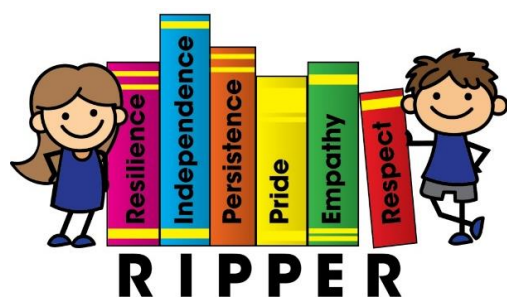
We started to plant the broccoli, then the cauliflowers.

We watched Mr John test the soil. He turned the soil into purple when he tested it.



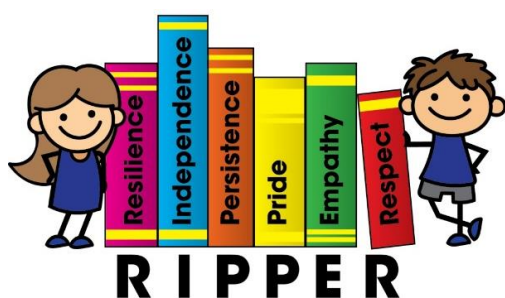
