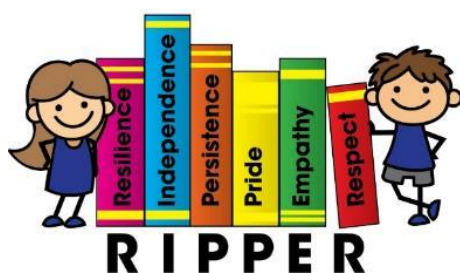
NETSETGO
